

This helps to create a more interesting and fun visual to the boring old utility wear with a colourful twist.









Just like Alice through a looking glass. This collection is about taking a creative look at an onion. There's more to life than yours.









This collection was inspired by the idea of the process of growth through a fall period. Like flowers, to bloom, we need to fall, and it takes courage.


This collection uses a variety of floral, knit, and chiffon fabrics in contrasting colours to portray the texture and individuality of flowers falling and blooming.




FASHION MARKETING
